MINISTERIAL ORDER

027/2017

PROHIBITION OF OPERATION OF OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES

As the Minister considers that a fire hazard or burning hazard warrants a prohibition on the operation of off-highway vehicles, as defined in the Act, I HEREBY ORDER:

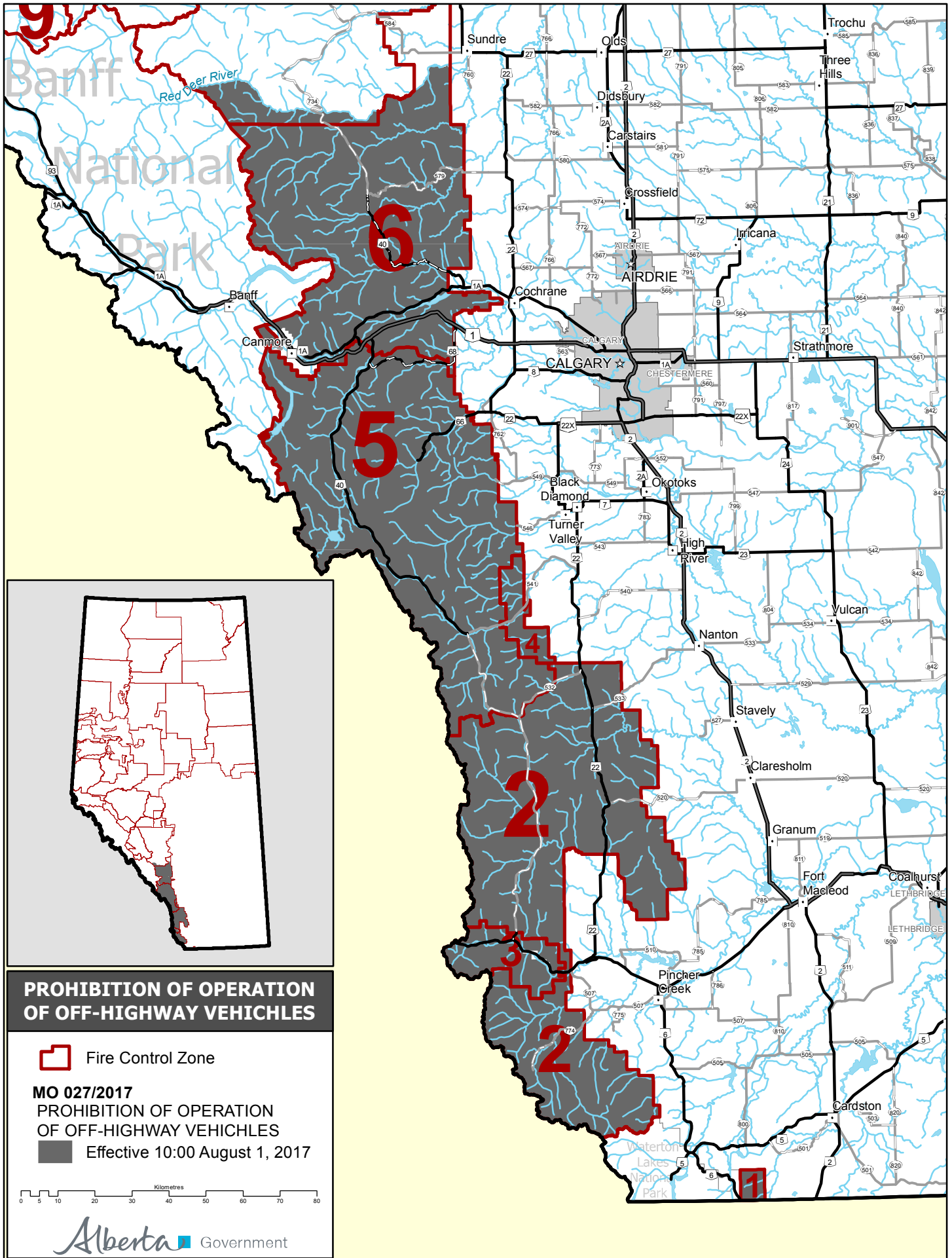
1. The operation of any off-highway vehicle, for recreational purposes, is prohibited on:

all lands within all of Fire Control Zones 1 – 5 inclusive, and those parts of Fire Control Zones 6 and 7 that lie south of the Red Deer River, as such Fire Control Zones are defined in the Fire Control Zone Regulation, being Alberta Regulation 29/2005.
2. This Order does not apply to the use of any off-highway vehicle:
 - (i) on private lands; or
 - (ii) by any individual when exercising a right recognized and affirmed under Part II of the Constitution Act, 1982 or a right under section 12 of the Natural Resources Transfer Agreement or when travelling to a location to exercise such a right;
3. This Order is made pursuant to section 14(1) of the *Forest and Prairie Protection Act*.
4. THIS ORDER comes into effect at 10:00 o'clock on the 1st day of August, 2017.
