FIRE CONTROL ORDER

1. I, Bruce Mayer, Acting Assistant Deputy Minister of Forestry Division of Sustainable Resource Development, pursuant to s.21 of the *Forest and Prairie Protection Act* (the "Act"), HEREBY:

- a. SUSPEND all fire permits issued under the Act,
- b. REQUIRE all outdoor fires presently burning whether set under the authority of a fire permit or not, extinguished, and
- c. PROHIBIT the lighting of outdoor fires

within all of Fire Control Zones 1, 2, 3 and 4 as established in the Fire Control Zone Regulation (Alta. Reg. 29/2005).

2. For greater certainty, THIS ORDER does not apply to:

- a. fires which are contained in cooking and heating appliances and which are fuelled by fluids or gases;
- b. fires contained in industrial facilities or on industrial sites approved by a forest officer; and
- c. fires contained in fire facilities located in designated camping and recreation areas.

3. THIS ORDER comes into effect at 12:01 o'clock p.m. on the 18th day of July, 2007.
