**MINISTERIAL ORDER**  
**18/06**

**FIRE CONTROL ORDER**

1. I, Brad Pickering, Deputy Minister of Sustainable Resource Development, pursuant to s.21 of the Forest and Prairie Protection Act (the "Act"), HEREBY:
  - a. SUSPEND all fire permits issued under the Act,
  - b. REQUIRE all outdoor fires presently burning whether set under the authority of a fire permit or not, extinguished, and
  - c. PROHIBIT the lighting of outdoor fires  
within all of Fire Control Zones 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,11 and 12 as established in the Fire Control Zone Regulation (Alta. Reg. 29/2005).
  
2. For greater certainty, THIS ORDER does not apply to:
  - a. fires which are contained in cooking and heating appliances and which are fuelled by fluids or gases;
  - b. fires contained in industrial facilities or on industrial sites approved by a forest officer; and
  - c. fires contained in fire facilities located in designated camping and recreation areas.

THIS ORDER comes into effect at 12:01 o'clock p.m. on the 18th day of May, 2006.
