MINISTERIAL ORDER

015/2019

PROHIBITION OF OPERATION OF OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES

As the Minister considers that a fire hazard or burning hazard warrants a prohibition on the operation of off-highway vehicles, as defined in the *Forest and Prairie Protection Act*, I HEREBY ORDER:

1. Subject to section 3 of this Order, the operation of any off-highway vehicle, for recreational purposes, is prohibited on all land located within those Fire Control Zones listed in section 2 of this Order.
2. This Order applies to the following Fire Control Zones:
 - a. Fire Control Zones 27- 38, inclusive, and
 - b. Fire Control Zones 42, 43, and 46.
3. This Order does not apply to the use of any off-highway vehicle :
 - a. On private lands; or
 - b. By any individual when exercising a right recognized and affirmed under Part II of the Constitution Act, 1982 or a right under section 12 of the Natural Resources Transfer Agreement or when travelling to a location to exercise such a right.
4. In this Order, a Fire Control Zone refers to the corresponding numbered Fire Control Zone established in the Fire Control Regulation (Alberta Regulation 29/2005).
5. This Order is made pursuant to section 14(1) of the *Forest and Prairie Protection Act*.

6. Ministerial Order 011/2019 is repealed.

THIS ORDER comes into effect at 16:00 on June 4, 2019.
